#### **POLICY 2006-1**

Wastewater Flow Tables Policy

#### Explanation

The Deep Creek Lake Sewer System (the "System") has been a project that has evolved and grown since its original design in the early 1980's. The initial design and subsequent expansion of the System, has been dependent upon an analysis of sewer capacity, which is expressed in terms of Equivalent Residential Units ("ERU's"). One ERU represents 262.5 gallons of daily wastewater flow.

In April 1996 the Garrett County Sanitary Commission, on behalf of the Garrett County Sanitary District, Inc. (the "District"), adopted a Wastewater Flow Table that was designed to calculate ERU's based upon estimated flows used by the Maryland Department of the Environment in designing septic systems. In July 2005, the Board of County Commissioners of Garrett County, Maryland, as the governing body of the District, amended the Flow Tables for restaurants having a 12 hour operation and bar stools in a bar area or tavern and adopted Policy 2005-7. Now, in March 2006, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of the District, has determined that the flows for certain other specific uses as reflected on the attached Wastewater Flow Tables Policy, more closely resemble the discharge exactly produced by specific uses. This Policy 2006-1 is intended to reflect the determination and action of the Board of County Commissioners in respect to the use of the Wastewater Flow Table in the Deep Creek Lake Sanitary District and is intended to replace Policy 2005-7.

## Wastewater Flow Tables Policy

1. It shall be the Policy of the Garrett County Department of Public Utilities, acting for and on behalf of the District that wastewater flows determination of required ERU's of facilities within the Deep Creek Lake Sanitary District shall be as follows:
