Dear Sirs:

Pursuant to the requirement of Police Accountability Act of 2021:

on or before December 31 each year, submit a report to the governing body of the county that:

- (1) identifies any trends in the disciplinary process of police officers in the County; and
- (2) makes recommendations on changes to policy that would improve police accountability in the County.

The Administrative Charging Committee reviewed and ruled on four (4) cases in 2023:

- ACC2023-001 Motor Vehicle Crash
Charges are founded, and the Deputy is Administrative Charged.
Recommendation-Formal written counseling as per SPDM
- ACC2023-002 Assault (MSP Incident # 22-MSO-037440)
Not Administratively Charged and the Deputy is exonerated.
- ACC2023-003 Assault
Not Administratively Charged and the Deputy is exonerated.
- ACC2024-004 Motor Vehicle Pursuit Across State Lines.
Charges are founded, and the Deputy is Administrative Charged.
Recommendation-Loss of 2 days' pay per SPDM.

The Police Accountability Board appreciates the input and cooperation of Sheriff Myers and his team. The PAB has no further recommendations.
