### § 21-1309. Multiple day licenses

**(a) Issuance.** -- The Board may issue a Class C multiple day beer license, beer and wine license, and beer, wine, and liquor license to a club for the following fees and license types:

- (1)** \$ 50 for a 2-day license;
- (2)** \$ 150 for a 6-day license; and
- (3)** \$ 300 for a 12-day license.

**(b) Hearing.** -- The Board is not required to hold a hearing before issuing a license under this section if:

- (1)** a license holder anticipates attendance of fewer than 500 individuals at an event; and
- (2)** the Board has approved a license for the license holder in the prior year.
