RESOLUTION – March 19, 2020

WITH RESPECT TO THE ORDER OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND NUMBER 20-03-19-02 EXPANDING ALCOHOL BEVERAGE DELIVERY AND CARRYOUT SERVICES, THE GARRETT COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS / LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD HAS THIS 19TH DAY OF MARCH, 2020, ISSUED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

The Garrett County Board of License Commissioners approved the following resolution authorizing Garrett County alcoholic beverage licensed establishments with a Class A, Class B or Class D license to so sell alcoholic beverages approved by their underlying license for carryout or delivery. While the Governor’s order to close all restaurants and taverns as a part of the catastrophic health emergency remains in effect, all restaurants and bars licensed by the Garrett County Board of License Commissioners may sell sealed containers of alcoholic beverages approved by their underlying license for off-premises consumption. This permission includes the sale of bottles, cans, growlers, and crowlers for off-premises consumption in sealed containers and does not include the sale of alcoholic drinks in a to-go cup. This permission expires when the emergency order to close restaurants and bars is lifted. Employees approved for the licensed businesses must be at least 21 years of age to deliver alcoholic beverages to a person of legal drinking in Garrett County. State law prohibits the delivery of alcohol by a third party, such as Grubhub or Uber Eats. License holders of the businesses must apply for this permission by completing the applicable forms, and permission will be granted administratively by Administrator to the Board of License Commissioners.

DULY ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF GARRETT COUNTY, MARYLAND, MARCH 19, 2020, TO TAKE EFFECT THE 19TH DAY OF MARCH 2020.
