1. Define infrastructure including water, sewer and transportation, but also the concepts of hard infrastructure such as light, heat and electricity, and soft infrastructure such as broadband, cable and other means of communication.
2. Define where these systems exist and whether the existing systems are adequate.
3. Discuss why having adequate infrastructure is imperative to the health and quality of life of the community.
4. If there are certain types/locations of infrastructure that is inadequate, identify its location and why it is inadequate.
5. Suggest specific short-term and long-term goals that can move the County toward a more adequate infrastructure system.
6. Water and sewer infrastructure is covered in other chapters, and transportation also has its own chapter. These types of infrastructure should be mentioned as part of the broader concepts within the infrastructure section, but the specifics should reside in their respective locations so as to avoid repetition.
