

APPEAL PROCESS

The Owner of any property who seeks to register, license, or is registered or licensed under the terms of this Ordinance, who is aggrieved by any officer, department, or board of the County affected by the decision of the Office of Licensing and Enforcement Management in respect to registration or licensing of a Transient Vacation Rental Unit under the terms of this Ordinance may appeal to the Transient Vacation Rental Unit Board of Appeals.

You may appeal by filing an application for appeal, in writing, within 30 days of the decision. The application must include your name, home address, and transient vacation rental unit address. The application for appeal must also state the reason for the appeal including any relevant supporting arguments to grant the appeal found in Section 8E of the Garrett County Transient Vacation Rental Unit Ordinance. The cost of an appeal is \$150.00 due at application. Checks should be made out to the Garrett County Commissioners.
