**Applicant must maintain a household in Garrett County.  
 This permit is ONLY for normal household waste generated  
 from YOUR home in Garrett County.**

Applicants may be required to show proof  
 of maintaining a **household** within Garrett  
 County. Current utility bills or property tax  
 statements detailing the address generating  
 household waste will be sufficient proof.  
 Applicants applying in person should bring  
 these items with them. Applicants applying by  
 mail or on-line may be requested to provide  
 these items by mail.

Out-of-county refuse, including recycling  
 items, are **not accepted** at any collection site  
 (including the landfill). A refuse permit is not  
 required to recycle or to cross the scales at  
 the Landfill for waste or recyclables generated  
 in Garrett County. **Credit cards may be used  
 online only.**

## Acceptable Waste (Permit Covers)

- Daily household waste from one household. (No sharing.)
- One individual piece of furniture, a table, a mattress set, a couch, etc.

## Waste Accepted at Landfill Only

### Fees apply to the following:

- Clean-up from house, garage, basement or attic.\*
- Construction/demolition debris, even if you are just remodeling a section of your own house.\*
- Commercial waste (waste generated by a business, even if the business is in your home).\*
- Brush, leaves, grass clippings, or other yard waste.\*
- Tires.\*
- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or dehumidifiers.\*
- Furniture and appliances such as water heaters, washer/dryers, stoves, or dishwashers.\* (Allowed at some collection sites with fee.)

\* These items generated in Garrett County may be brought to the main landfill for disposal (no permit is required) (fees do apply).

## Unaccepted Waste (Permit Does Not Cover)

Waste that is not accepted at the landfill/collection sites (liquid waste, lead acid batteries, propane tanks, paint cans [unless empty/dry]).

## PROCEDURE FOR REPLACING PERMITS

If you trade your vehicle or replace your windshield and require a replacement permit, we will issue a new permit free.

To obtain the replacement, call the Landfill Office at 301-387-0322, during normal business hours.

Your old permit will be cancelled and no longer valid for access to the refuse sites.

You should receive your replacement permit by mail within a few days.

## FREE RECYCLING!

*Garrett County residents, businesses and visitors do not need a refuse permit to recycle materials generated in Garrett County.*

### The following materials may be recycled at the Garrett County Landfill and/or Refuse and Recycling Sites:

- Aluminum beverage cans (soda and beer)
- Corrugated cardboard, shiny cardboard, clean pizza boxes
- Newsprint, telephone books and paperback books (with covers removed)
- Clear, green, blue and brown glass bottles and jars
- Assorted office paper—Landfill, Bumble Bee, Grantsville, Garrett Hwy. and King's Run
- PET #1 plastic (water and soda bottles)—Grantsville, Bumble Bee, King's Run, Garrett Hwy., and the Landfill.
- HDPE #2 plastic (milk and laundry detergent jugs, etc.)—Grantsville, King's Run, Bumble Bee, Garrett Hwy., and the Landfill.
- Used motor oil and antifreeze—Grantsville, Bumble Bee, Garrett Hwy., Backbone Mtn., King's Run and Landfill. Oil filters—Garrett Hwy., King's Run, Grantsville, 135, Bumble Bee and the Landfill.
- Magazines and shiny papers—Landfill, Bumble Bee, Grantsville, Garrett Hwy. and King's Run.
- Electronics/computers/printers, etc.—Bumble Bee, Garrett Hwy., Grantsville, King's Run, and the Landfill.
- Fluorescent bulbs (homeowners only)—Landfill
- Any Metal Items—All seven locations
