BOARD OF GARRETT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC MEETING January 14, 2014

ADMINISTRATIVE SESSION

- Mr. Pagenhardt reviewed a number of administrative, personnel, and managerial matters under his authority and jurisdiction with the Board of County Commissioners. No official action was taken by the Board at this time.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners reviewed the existing entrance and grading/stormwater permit fees. In attendance for this session was John Nelson, Director, Department of Planning and Land Development; James Torrington, Division Chief, Division of Permits and Inspections, Department of Planning and Land Development; Jay Moyer, Director, Department of Public Works; and Michael Koch, Director, Department of Economic Development. Discussion also included permit and impact fees which the County has the authority through enabling legislation to implement. Mr. Torrington was asked to prepare an amended fee schedule based on a number of criteria, comparison with other jurisdictions, and equity. The County Attorney will be asked to participate in this review.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners reviewed the decision that the Board must finalize on the Amendment Petition submitted by William Meagher to amend the Deep Creek Watershed Zoning Ordinance. In attendance for this session were Mr. Nelson and Mr. Koch. The Board will continue to take this matter under advisement and a follow-up session with the County Attorney will be scheduled.
- 4. The Board of County Commissioners, on a motion by Commissioner Crawford, which was seconded by Commissioner Raley, and made unanimous by Chairman Gatto, moved into Executive Session under section 10-508 of the Maryland Open Meetings Law on this date to discuss economic development matters. The same motion ended the Executive Session.
- 5. The Board of County Commissioners met with Cindy Stone with the State of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development to discuss Community Development Block Grant Programs and Projects. The Board of County Commissioners, on a motion by Commissioner Raley, which was seconded by Commissioner Crawford, and made unanimous by Chairman Gatto, re-appointed George Bishoff, Hoover Myers, Charles Mason, and Carl Bender to the Garrett County Ag Preservation Committee. The same motion appointed Paul Petersheim as Member and Gary Berkebile as Alternate Member. Official letters of appointment will be sent to all appointees under the signature of Chairman Gatto.
