The Board of County Commissioners agreed to request proposals for the operation of the Garrett County Animal Shelter and/or Animal Control.
- 2. Ms. Annie Bristow provided information on underground gas storage, specifically the Accident Dome storage facility, and how the recent accident at an underground gas storage facility in Southern California affected the community there.
- 3. Mr. Null reviewed a number of administrative, non-privileged, personnel, and managerial matters under his authority and jurisdiction with the Board of County Commissioners.

 Resolution-Adoption of Road Names in the North Camp Ridge subdivision: Campfire Drive, Fork Run Trail,
 Fox Run Drive, High Road Crest, Ridgeline Trail, Rocky Gap Trail, Summer Camp Lane, and Snowy Creek
 Lane (a lane off of Snowy Creek Road). The Board of County Commissioners, on a motion by
 Commissioner Hinebaugh, which was seconded by Commissioner Tichnell, and made unanimous by
 Chairman Edwards, approved the Resolution.

4. Garrett County Purchasing Department

RFP # 15-1201 - Preliminary Engineering & Environmental Reports, Utilities Department

Eight (8) bids were received to provide engineering & environmental reports for the Deep Creek Lake

Wastewater Treatment Plant Enhanced Nutrient Removal Upgrade and the Trout Run Wastewater

Treatment Plant Upgrades. The Purchasing Department recommended awarding the contract to Rummel,

Klepper and Kahl, LLP in the amount of \$55,144. The Board of County Commissioners, on a motion by

Commissioner Tichnell, which was seconded by Commissioner Hinebaugh, and made unanimous by

Chairman Edwards, approved awarding the contract as recommended.

RFP # 15-1217H – HVAC Services

Three (3) bids were received to provide HVAC services. The Purchasing Department recommended awarding the contract to Beitzel Corporation for a fix cost of \$74.00 per hour. The Board of County Commissioners, on a motion by Commissioner Hinebaugh, which was seconded by Commissioner Tichnell, and made unanimous by Chairman Edwards, approved awarding the contract as recommended.

5. Public Comment

- Ms. Annie Bristow provided copies of a handout concerning underground gas storage information previously provided to the Board of County Commissioners in the Administrative Session.
- Mr. Thomas Spiker requested the support of the Board of County Commissioners in dealing with Maryland State Highway Administration over the contamination of his well due to road salt. Mr. Spiker has also been in contact with Senator Edwards and Delegate Beitzel concerning this issue. The Board recognizes that well contamination, especially in the Grantsville area, is an on-going concern.
- 6. In compliance with the Maryland Open Meetings Act under Section 10-509, a record of the Executive Session for January 4, 2016 is hereby documented on this date, the next open/public meeting of the Board of County Commissioners.
