MINUTES

The Garrett County Board of License Commissioners / Liquor Control Board held their December meeting in the Commissioner's Office on Tuesday, November 22, 2016 at 3:00 PM. Present for the meeting was Chairperson David Moe, Commissioner Lisa Herman and Administrator to the Board Deborah R. Owston.

Chairperson Moe called the meeting to order. The Board signed mileage sheets. The expense reports for July thru December 2016 were approved for mileage reimbursement.

The November 3, 2016 minutes were reviewed and approved by the Board. Chairperson Moe made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Herman and approved.

No hearings were held. The Board meet to discuss the legislative requests to be introduced at the upcoming Garrett County legislative meetings. The Board will request an amendment to expand the Sunday hours were permitted by referendum vote. A housekeeping amendment to repeal the Sunday Sales Option fees will be requested. This is a result of the new 7-day license fee structure that took place on October 1, 2016. A housekeeping amendment will be requested to repeal the Class D Sunday sales subsections that reference the building, seating and commercial kitchen requirements. This amendment is a result of the legislative change that repealed the meal requirement on July 1, 2015. In addition, corrective bill amendments to the new Alcoholic Beverages Article will be submitted to the Legislative Services Office. The Garrett County Commissioner's legislative meeting will be December 5, 2016 at 4:15 PM in the Public Meeting Room. Senator Edwards and Delegate Beitzel's legislative meeting will be December 6, 2016 at 6:30 PM at Garrett College. A Sunday Sales Referendum vote took place on November 8, 2016. The majority of districts and precincts of a district received favorable votes. As soon as the votes are official, the information will be made posted on the website. Terry Breault contacted the office about applying for a license to be used at the Oakland Golf Course. Eastern Garrett VFD conducted a fundraiser event on November 19, 2016. Pizza Hut's local resident licensee change took place on November 21, 2016. Joseph Clemons replaced Bryan Edwards. Canoe On The Run upgraded their Class B B&W On-Sale license to a 7-day license on November 17, 2016. Pawn Run received a letter of violation from the Health Department in reference to bacteria in the water.

There being no further business to discuss, Chairperson Moe made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Herman seconded the motion.
