SE-471- an application submitted by John Kyle P. Newsome & Kristi A. (Spicknall) Newsome for a Special Exception for an Electric Power Generating Solar Array. The property is located at 3573 Sand Flat Road, tax map 66, parcel 76 & 506, grid 14 and is zoned Lake Residential 2 (LR2). The Commission offered no comment

SE-472- an application submitted by Hugh D. Umbel T/A Legacy Home Corp. for MB Vacations, LLC, for a Special Exception for a 8 bedroom Transient Vacation Rental Unit.
