- 1. <u>Additions/deletions to Public Meeting Agenda</u>. Mr. Pagenhardt indicated there were no additions or deletions to the Public Meeting Agenda for April 5, 2011. Mr. Pagenhardt also noted several matters to be discussed during the administrative and executive sessions on this date.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners, on a motion by Commissioner Raley, which was seconded and carried by Commissioner Gatto, approved the Public Meeting Minutes for March 17, 2011.
